Leo began his studies at the Art Institute of Boston at Lesley University in 1999. During a semester abroad in Florence, Italy, Leo discovered The Florence Academy

of Art, where he began studies in 2001.

After graduating in 2005, Leo was asked to stay on at the school, first as an instructor and subsequently director of the school's drawing program for sculptors. Additionally, Leo taught regular courses in plein-air landscape painting and artist materials until leaving the school in 2011.

Leo has relocated to his native Massachusetts, now working and teaching from his studio in a former mill building in Waltham, MA. Based on his classical training, he has developed his own impressionistic style.



Whether working en plein-air or in the studio Leo works with traditional materials, his own handground paints, canvases and oils. Leo's paintings can be found in private collections worldwide.
