Bill Lane: Watercolorist

Everyday scenes from life intrigue Bill -- a skyline, boats at the dock or city life on a busy day. He observes how the light plays into the scene and dances off the subjects. Because of this, he always works light to dark, saving



those light values for the "sweet" spots in the painting.

He enjoys plein air painting whenever possible but New England winters, which make for frozen watercolors, tend to keep him indoors.

Christine Qian has painting experience and is newly returning to art. Linda Porreca paints in watercolor and acrylics.


