Jack Haran -- Watercolorist

Watercolor artist Jack Haran is past president of the New England Watercolor Society (NEWS) and past President

of North River Arts Society (NRAS). He sits on the Board of Directors for both NEWS and NRAS. He earned a BS in Fine Arts from Northeastern University and a School of the Museum of Fine Arts diploma. He has studied with Tony Van Hasselt and Judi Wagner, Zygmond Jankowski, John Kilroy, Alvaro Castagnet and Joseph Zbukvic.

Jack has exhibited in many solo, group and juried shows over the years. These shows have included local, regional, national and international exhibits. His most prestigious award is the Di Di Deglin Award at the 145th American Watercolor Society Show. He has received the bronze medal in New England Watercolor Society members show, North River Arts' A. A. Willis Drawing Award (twice) and Phyllis Howard Memorial Watercolor Award. Most recently he received First Place in the Rhode Island Watercolor Society National Exhibit in Pawtucket, RI.

Jack has coordinated watercolor workshops with international artists including Joseph Zbukvic, Alvaro Castagnet, John Salminen, Don Andrews, Thomas Schaller, and Frank Webb. He has given numerous watercolor demonstrations and taught

watercolor classes at the North River Arts Society. Jack is also a skilled draughtsman and has received awards for his works in charcoal.

Jack is a member of NEWS, NRAS, Rhode Island Watercolor Society, Cape Cod Art Association, Plymouth Guild, South Shore Art Center, and the American Watercolor Society – associate Member. His work is part of collections at Georgetown University, Italy, and Cultural Museum in Colonia de Sacramento, Uruguay as well as private collections.

Artist of the Month: Chris Roberts



Chris Roberts lives in Hyde Park and enjoys the sense of community within the art world which she experienced in Roslindale as well before moving here. Retired from the world of dental research, time is more available to her to pursue art as she chooses! She is a board member of the

Dedham Art Association and also belongs to the Hyde Park and West Roxbury Art Associations. Additionally, she is a member and past co-President of a calligraphy guild, Masscribes. She takes weekly classes in Lincoln with a group of women, WomenInk, whose works were featured in the winter of 2018 at the Menino Arts Center.

Formal art school was not destined to be in Chris' youth, but she was encouraged by her parents and teachers in her formative years. As Chris states, "I was lucky to get the art gene!" Her education came in the way of adult-education classes in local schools and Cambridge. Over time she took workshops on Cape Cod and Maine. Then she had a chance to attend a watercolor workshop in Brittany France, through a Boston based gallery and Chris seized the opportunity. That was 2001, just a couple of weeks before 9/11 and might not have otherwise happened. In 2004, she went again to Tuscany with the same instructor, former Dedham resident, Nancy Howell, and enjoyed the landscapes and light of Italy.

Since then, Chris has been involved in organizations and the networks based in local communities. Calligraphy, watercolors and pastels are the mediums Chris explores. Pet portraits, landscapes, wedding invitations, and card-making are all on the busy to-do list Chris has. Living in a home with a sweet cat, she hosts Airbnb guests from around the country and world, and has two cherished grandchildren.
