Nancy Howell, Watercolorist



A native of
Massachusetts, Nancy
Sargent Howell attended
Skidmore College as an art
major, where, having
explored many color and
design classes, and
assisted in teaching a
drawing class, she soon
fell in love with watercolor
painting. "Watercolors
don't always do what you

expect", she says, "and although that can be frustrating, it also sends me into unplanned directions which I find very energizing." Although much of Nancy's work is done outdoors, she uses the information that she gathers from plein air paintings to develop studio work that has a more abstract quality. She often uses a method of glazing her work that she calls "prisming." "I don't know where the ideas come from," she says, " but after I had been

doing it for a while, I realized that, as a child, I loved cubist paintings and have always loved jigsaw puzzles."

In recent years, Nancy has started doing more acrylic paintings and is finding that the combination of all the water media is working together. "I love the vibrancy of acrylics so that my watercolors are becoming stronger. I'm now a lot more excited about the basic shapes that I make when I plan my paintings and they are helping to create more interesting compositions. I have recently been taking old, abstract paintings and placing new information on top of them, sometimes using collage to add more excitement. Often, they have a recognizable subject in them but are settled into a very geometric background. It's always interesting to take a bit of my past and put what I love today on top of it."

Fen Zhou Artist of the Month for April



"I am a brain tumor survivor going on eight years. I retired from Harvard Medical School after 27 years as a Senior Researcher in the field of molecular biology to focus fully on recovering and healing from my brain surgery. At the very beginning of my retirement life, I

was not clear what I wanted to do or what I was able to do. One day, from my basement I found the broken pieces of an ancient Chinese tri-colored glazed horse pottery piece. I thought to myself, I should reassemble this again and I did! From there, I began to think that I might try my hand at some artwork.

I started painting from ground zero, with no background, experience, or instruction. In the Sharon Adult Community Center I met many great artists and friends as well as my first art teacher, Dorothy Appel. I learned watercolor and acrylic painting from her. More recently I have begun learning to paint with Oil from Laura Lee Zanghetti and Matt Miller. Discovering this art world has made my retirement life much more exciting and meaningful. I am interested in painting the four seasons, landscapes, still life, and animal portraits. I would like to use the canvas to capture a memory of every place where I have visited. I love to use the brush and colors to express the beauty of nature. I see how people love and care for animals and this feeling makes me want to explore showing people and animals together in harmony.

I have joined the Sharon, Canton, and Foxboro Art Associations, and have begun to feature my own artwork in some local library gallery exhibitions. From 2016-2018 I received several awards from local juried art shows which have meant a lot to me

as a new artist starting out from nothing. In 2019, my painting received the Best in Show award at the Canton Spring Art Show. And in 2020, my painting received the Art Excellence Award from the Dedham Art Association. I currently live happily in Sharon, Massachusetts."
